Knook	1	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From the Heytesbury Parish boundary, about 137 m south of the Southampton – Bath Trunk Road, A.36, leading south-east along the Heytesbury Parish boundary to the northern end of spur road U/C 9037. Approximate length 550 m. Width 1 m.	relevant date 6th October 1992
Knook	2	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From the southern end of spur road U/C 9037 leading south-east past East Farm to its junction with path No.3 on the Upton Lovell Parish boundary. Approximate length 457 m. Width 0.5 m.	relevant date 6th October 1992
Knook	3	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From path No.2 leading north-east along the Upton Lovell Parish boundary to the Southampton – Bath Trunk Road, A.36(T). Approximate length 183 m. Width 0.5 m.	relevant date 6th October 1992
Knook	4	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From the western end of road U/C 9037 leading south-west and south to the Boyton Parish boundary. Approximate length 595 m. Width 0.5 m.	relevant date 6th October 1992
Knook	5	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> From the Heytesbury Parish boundary leading south-east and south to path No.4. Approximate length 275 m. Width 0.5 m.	relevant date 6th October 1992

Knook	9	<u>CRB.</u> From the Heytesbury – Shrewton road, A.390, leading north-east and north-west to Willis's Field Barn, then north-east across the Old Ditch to the Imber Range Danger area boundary. Approximate length 1.8 k.m. Width 7.6 - 3 m.	relevant date 6th October 1992
Knook	11	<u>BYWAY.</u> From Upton Lovell path No.2 by Knook Castle leading north-north-east along the old ditch to the Imber Range Danger Area boundary. Approximate length 457 m.	relevant date 6th October 1992
Knook	13	<u>BRIDLEWAY.</u> From the Southampton – Bath Trunk Road, A36, south of West Farm, leading east, then north-east to its junction with path No. 6 in the parish of Upton Lovell. Approximate length: 770m Width 3.5m	relevant date 5 th August, 1999 subject to ploughing
Knook	14A	<u>BRIDLEWAY</u> leading from the Heytesbury parish boundary and path no 16A along track and northern verge to its junction with Knook path no 9 north east of Knook Down House. Width 9 metres Approximate length 570metres	Relevant date 7 th May 2015
Knook	16	<u>FOOTPATH.</u> Part of the Imber Range Perimeter Path. From Heytesbury path No.21 leading east-south-east across the old ditch and east to Upton Lovell path No.17, north of Knook Castle. Approximate length 770 m.	relevant date 6th October 1992
